who is originally from Nigeria. He and his family moved to the United States eight years ago. Prior to that, he was a Pastor for more than ten years. He also taught at the Seminary back in Nigeria for seven years.

While in the United States, he has assumed several pastoral roles and is often invited to preach in different churches.

Seth is married to Zainab and together they are blessed with three lovely children; a daughter (8) and two sons (6 & 4). Zainab is currently a student at Princeton Theological Seminary, NJ.

Seth has five graduate degrees, the most recent being a Master of Divinity from Westminster Theological Seminary, PA and a Master of Sacred Theology from Yale University, CT. He is the Founder of Replica Church and the author of the Motivation Bible Commentary Series.

OLD TESTAMENT READING

Exodus 24:12-18

The Lord said to Moses, "Come up to me on the mountain, and wait there; and I will give you the tablets of stone, with the law and the commandment, which I have written for their instruction."
