The Cross

Did you notice the large wooden cross that appeared in the chancel of our church? Do you know why it suddenly appeared there? Did you pay attention to its transformation over the weeks it was there?

Calvary's annual tradition is for the 6-foot

tall cross to be placed there at the beginning of the Lenten season – Ash Wednesday. For the forty days of Lent, it is draped with a purple cloth to remind us of Christ's preparation for suffering and crucifixion. At the conclusion of our Thursday Maundy worship service commemorating the Last Supper, the drape is solemnly removed from the cross, along with the adorning cloth the pulpit. In churches that have a Good Friday service, the cross is then draped in black.

Worshipers arriving on Easter Sunday found the cross draped in radiant white – the symbol of Christ's Resurrection. For the seven Sundays in the Easter season, the pulpit cloth and stoles on the choir members' robes were also white.




This year Calvary added something new to our tradition. Our cross remained at the front of the church until the last Sunday in June – June 25. At that time, we retired the cross until next year with a joyful celebration of life, by adorning the cross with fresh flowers from our gardens.

On June 25, worshippers brought handfuls of fresh flowers from our garden, or from the store, to our 10:00 worship service. As the service began we gathered at the cross to tuck the flowers into ribbons wrapped around it. The result was a living cross – a powerful symbol of our faith.


